### **VISA REGULATIONS FOR VISITORS TO TANZANIA**

1. Submit (i) One duly completed visa application form, (ii) A valid passport at least 6 months before expiration date with 2 blank pgs. Note; Amendment pgs are not for visa issuance, (iii) Two standard passport sized photos. (measurements 2x2) (iv) COPIES of travel itineraries; AIR and INLAND are MANDATORY. (v) Volunteer visa - LETTER from the HOST is MANDATORY (vi) Business visa - LETTER from Employer/and the HOST in Tanzania is MANDATORY.
2. Visa fee for US citizens is \$100 (CASH or MONEY ORDER/CASHIER'S CHECK payable to TANZANIA MISSION TO THE U.N.) for a 1 year multiple entry visa. European nationals' visa fee is \$ 50 for a six months single entry. For all other nationals' visa fee may vary from one country to another depending on reciprocity arrangements. An extra \$ 20.00 is charged for rush service (24 hrs.) Regular service is 3-5 business days. **Personal Checks are NOT ACCEPTED!**
3. If applying by mail please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope (meter stamps are not accepted) (Registered, Certified Priority, Express mail, or UPS)
4. Nationals of the following countries do not require visas when the intended stay does not exceed three months: Namibia, Rwanda, Romania and Commonwealth Member States **EXCEPT FOR THE UNITED KINGDOM, CANADA, AUSTRALIA, AND INDIA.**
5. Nationals of the following countries must have their request for visas referred to the Director of Immigration Services in Tanzania.  
  
Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Egypt, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Liberia, Morocco, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Saudi Arabia, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkey, Yemen, Refugees Stateless Persons, West and Central African Nationals **EXCEPT FOR BENIN, BURKINA FASO, CAMEROUN, COTE D'IVORE, GABON, GAMBIA, GHANA , GUINEA, GUINEA-BISSAU, TOGO, AND WESTERN SAHARA.** It should be noted that all visitors who fall under this category may not be allowed entry into Tanzania without being in possession of Referred visa (Allow maximum of 6 weeks for processing, allow minimum of 4 weeks for processing).
6. Visas for Research and Journalism will only be granted after the applicants have been cleared by the Commission of Science and Technology (COSTECH). Call the Mission/Embassy for further information.
7. Visas may be obtained from any Tanzanian Diplomatic Mission abroad, or upon arrival at any point of entry in Tanzania, but it is advisable to secure visas before commencing your journey whenever possible. In the United States visa can be obtained from the Mission in New York or at the Embassy in Washington DC.
